Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

Total Abortions (2015): 12,479

The Arizona Department of Health Services reports that 12,479 abortions took place in Arizona during 2015.

SOCIAL MEDIA GRAPHICS:

In 2013, 13.6% of pregnancies in Arizona ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares Arizona abortion percentages by year.

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 1.0% of the abortions that took place in Arizona were performed on out-of-state residents.

# Total Abortions (2014): 12,870

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 12,870 abortions took place in Arizona during 2014. In 2011, there were 16,100 abortions reported—compared with 19,500 in 2008 and 19,480 in 2005

# Abortion Rate\* (2014): 9.8

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for Arizona was 9.8. In 2011, the abortion rate in Arizona was 12.7. It was 15.2 in 2008, 16.0 in 2005, and 16.5 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

\*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

# Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 13%

In 2011, 120,400 women in Arizona became pregnant. 71% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 13% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

#### Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 1.4%

In 2014, 1.4% of all U.S. abortions occurred in Arizona.

#### Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 17

In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 17 abortion providers in Arizona. There were 19 providers in 2008, 19 providers in 2005, and 21 providers in 2000.

#### State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- A woman must receive state-directed counseling about abortion and then wait 24 hours before the abortion takes place.
- Health plans offered in the state's health exchange can only cover abortion in cases of life endangerment or severe health threats.
- The use of telemedicine for the performance of medication abortion is prohibited.
- The parent of a minor must consent before an abortion can take place.
- A woman must undergo an ultrasound at least 24 hours before the abortion takes place and must be given the option to view the image.
