Collective state abortion statistics are gathered privately by the Guttmacher Institute and federally by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

STATE-LEVEL DATA

Total Abortions (2015): 31,009

The Georgia Department of Public Health reports that 31,009 abortions took place in Georgia during 2015.

Total Abortions (2014): 30,013

The Georgia Department of Public Health reports that 30,013 abortions took place in Georgia during 2014.

Total Abortions (2013): 30,673

SOCIAL MEDIA GRAPHICS:

In 2013, 19.2% of pregnancies in Georgia ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares Georgia abortion percentages by year.

Out-of-State Abortion Percentage (2013): 11.1%

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 11.1% of the abortions that took place in Georgia were performed on out-of-state residents.

GUTTMACHER DATA

Total Abortions (2014): 33,000

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 33,000 abortions took place in Georgia during 2014. In 2011, there were 34,910 abortions reported—compared with 39,820 in 2008 and 33,180 in 2005

Abortion Rate* (2014): 15.7

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for Georgia was 15.7. In 2011, the abortion rate in Georgia was 16.8. It was 19.2 in 2008, 16.3 in 2005, and 16.9 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 18%

In 2011, 197,300 women in Georgia became pregnant. 67% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 18% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 8.6%

In 2014, 8.6% of all U.S. abortions occurred in Georgia.

Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 28

In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 28 abortion providers in Georgia. There were 32 providers in 2008, 34 providers in 2005, and 26 providers in 2000.

State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- A woman must receive state-directed counseling about abortion and then wait 48 hours before the abortion takes place.
- Health plans offered in the state's health exchange can only cover abortion in cases of life endangerm.
- The parent of a minor must be notified before an abortion can take place.
- Public funding is available for abortion only in cases of life endangerment, rape or incest.


