Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

Total Abortions (2015): 34,498

The Illinois Department of Public Health reports that 34,498 abortions took place in Illinois during 2015.

Total Abortions (2014): 38,472

The Illinois Department of Public Health reports that 38,472 abortions took place in Illinois during 2014.

SOCIAL MEDIA GRAPHICS:

In 2013, 20.6% of pregnancies in Illinois ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares Illinois abortion percentages by year.

Out-of-State Abortion Percentage (2013): 7.9%

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 7.9% of the abortions that took place in Illinois were performed on out-of-state residents.

GUTTMACHER DATA

Total Abortions (2014): 42,270

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 42,270 abortions took place in Illinois during 2014. In 2011, there were 44,580 abortions reported—compared with 54,920 in 2008 and 50,970 in 2005.

Abortion Rate* (2014): 16.3

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for Illinois was 16.3. In 2011, the abortion rate in Illinois was 17. It was 20.5 in 2008, 18.9 in 2005, and 23.2 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 18%

In 2011, 242,600 women in Illinois became pregnant. 66% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 18% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 4.6%

In 2014, 4.6% of all U.S. abortions occurred in Illinois.

Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 37


In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 37 abortion providers in Illinois. There were 37 providers in 2008, 38 providers in 2005, and 37 providers in 2000.

State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- Abortion is covered in insurance policies for public employees only in cases of life endangerment—unless an optional rider is purchased.
- The parent of a minor must be notified before an abortion can take place.
