Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

Total Abortions (2015): 6,931

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment reports that 6,931 abortions took place in Kansas during 2015.

Total Abortions (2014): 7,219

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment reports that 7,219 abortions took place in Kansas during 2014.

SOCIAL MEDIA GRAPHICS:

In 2013, 16.0% of pregnancies in Kansas ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares Kansas abortion percentages by year.

Out-of-State Abortion Percentage (2013): 50.1%

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 50.1% of the abortions that took place in Kansas were performed on out-of-state residents.

GUTTMACHER DATA

Total Abortions (2014): 7,240

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 7,240 abortions took place in Kansas during 2014. In 2011, there were 6,940 abortions reported—compared with 10,620 in 2008 and 10,410 in 2005.

Abortion Rate* (2014): 12.9

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for Kansas was 12.9. In 2011, the abortion rate in Kansas was 12.5. It was 19.2 in 2008, 18.4 in 2005, and 21.4 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 13%

In 2011, 55,200 women in Kansas became pregnant. 72% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 13% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 0.8%

In 2014, 0.8% of all U.S. abortions occurred in Kansas.

Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 3

In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 3 abortion providers in Kansas. There were 4 providers in 2008, 7 providers in 2005, and 7 providers in 2000.

State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- A woman must receive state-directed counseling about abortion and then wait 24 hours before the abortion takes place.
- Public and private health insurance can only cover abortion in cases of life endangerment—unless an optional rider is purchased.
- Health plans offered in the state's health exchange can only cover abortion in cases of life endangerment.
- The use of telemedicine for the performance of medication abortion is prohibited.
- The parent of a minor must consent before an abortion can take place.
- Public funding is available for abortion only in cases of life endangerment, rape or incest.
- A woman must undergo an ultrasound before obtaining an abortion and must be given the option to view the image.
- An abortion cannot be performed at or after 20 weeks postfertilization (22 weeks
 after the woman's last menstrual period) unless the woman's life is endangered or
 her physical health is severely compromised.
