Collective state abortion statistics are gathered privately by the Guttmacher Institute and federally by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

Total Abortions (2015): 9,861

The Minnesota Department of Health reports that 9,861 abortions took place in Minnesota during 2015.



SOCIAL MEDIA GRAPHICS:

In 2013, 12.5% of pregnancies in Minnesota ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares Minnesota abortion percentages by year.

# Out-of-State Abortion Percentage (2013): 8.8%

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 8.8% of the abortions that took place in Minnesota were performed on out-of-state residents.

# Total Abortions (2014): 9,760

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 9,760 abortions took place in Minnesota during 2014. In 2011, there were 11,140 abortions reported—compared with 13,060 in 2008 and 13,910 in 2005.

## Abortion Rate\* (2014): 9.3

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for Minnesota was 9.3. In 2011, the abortion rate in Minnesota was 10.7. It was 12.7 in 2008, 12.7 in 2005, and 13.5 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

\*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

# Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 12%

In 2011, 94,300 women in Minnesota became pregnant. 73% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 12% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

#### Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 1.1%

In 2014, 1.1% of all U.S. abortions occurred in Minnesota.

#### Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 15

In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 15 abortion providers in Minnesota. There were 14 providers in 2008, 11 providers in 2005, and 11 providers in 2000.

#### State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- A woman must receive state-directed counseling about abortion and then wait 24 hours before the abortion takes place.
- The parent of a minor must be notified before an abortion can take place.


