Collective state abortion statistics are gathered privately by the Guttmacher Institute and federally by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC). Because of reporting lag, their most recent data is generally 2-3 years old. In most cases, state-level abortion facts are more current than the numbers reported by AGI or the CDC.

STATE-LEVEL DATA

Total Abortions (2014): 1,730

The West Virginia Department of Health & Human Resources reports that 1,730 abortions took place in West Virginia during 2014.

CDC DATA

Total Abortions (2013): 1,876

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 1,876 abortions took place in West Virginia during 2013. The table below compares West Virginia abortion totals by year.

Abortion Percentage (2013): 8.3%

In 2013, 8.3% of pregnancies in West Virginia ended in abortion. This number does not take into account miscarriages. It was arrived at by dividing the state abortion ratio by the sum of the abortion ratio plus 1,000. The abortion ratio is the number of abortions that occurred per 1,000 lives births. The table below compares West Virginia abortion percentages by year.

Out-of-State Abortion Percentage (2013): 15.4%

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) reports that 15.4% of the abortions that took place in West Virginia were performed on out-of-state residents.

*U.S. averages are limited to reporting districts.

GUTTMACHER DATA

Total Abortions (2014): 2,020

The Guttmacher Institute reports that 2,020 abortions took place in West Virginia during 2014. In 2011, there were 2,390 abortions reported—compared with 2,280 in 2008 and 2,360 in 2005.

Abortion Rate* (2014): 6

The Guttmacher Institute reports that the 2014 abortion rate for West Virginia was 6. In 2011, the abortion rate in West Virginia was 7. It was 6.6 in 2008, 6.7 in 2005, and 6.8 in 2000. The 2014 abortion rate across the entire United States was 14.6.

*The abortion rate is the number of abortions per 1,000 women aged 15-44 years.

Percentage of Pregnancies Ending in Abortion (2011): 9%

In 2011, 27,500 women in West Virginia became pregnant. 75% of these pregnancies resulted in live births and 9% in induced abortions. The remaining pregnancies ended in miscarriage.

Percentage of All U.S. Abortions (2014): 0.2%

In 2014, 0.2% of all U.S. abortions occurred in West Virginia.

Facilities That Perform Abortions (2011): 4

In 2011, the Guttmacher Institute reports that there were 4 abortion providers in West Virginia. There were 4 providers in 2008, 4 providers in 2005, and 3 providers in 2000.

State Abortion Restrictions (2016):

- A woman must receive state-directed counseling about abortion and then wait 24 hours before the abortion takes place.
- The parent of a minor must be notified before an abortion can take place.
- An abortion cannot be performed at or after 20 weeks postfertilization (22 weeks
 after the woman's last menstrual period) unless the woman's life is endangered or
 her physical health is severely compromised.
